How to Read this Map:
 Trails are colored by proposed use and stacked to show what use is primary, secondary, etc... The first icon in row will always be the primary use, and read left to right. Trail label colors correspond with the proposed primary use. Primary trails are stacked at the top, secondary below that, and so on. Solid lines indicate existing trails and dashed lines indicate new trails.

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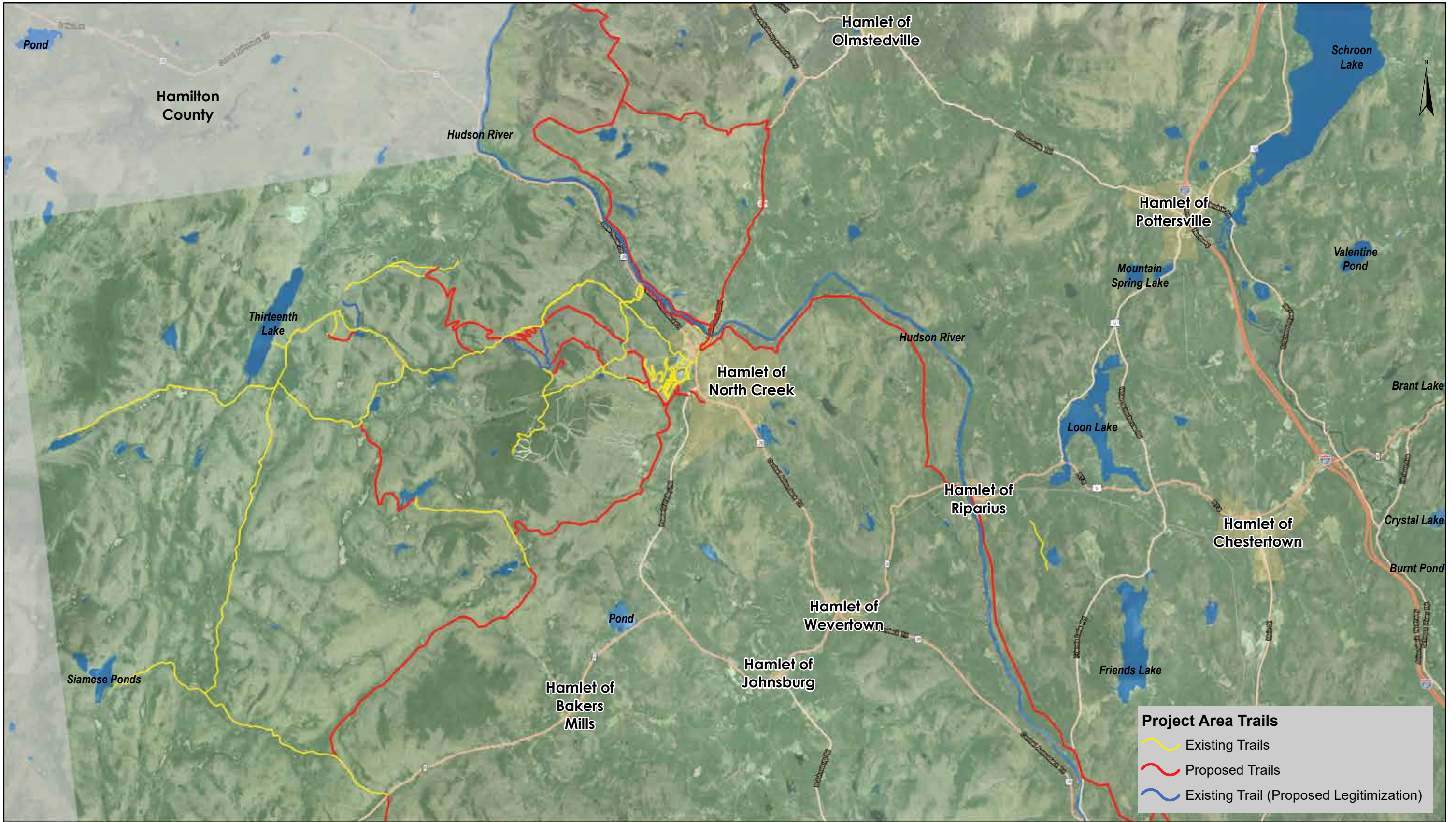
